- The belt was a thick leather that usually had a short apron at the front to offer some protection, however its function was much more than that.
- The belt was fastened tightly in preparedness for battle, to have it loose was to be off duty.
- The scabbard for the sword was slung from the belt.
- The placement of the belt also held the tunic in and supported the breastplate.
