Read Mark 11:1 - 11

Anything new from this passage?

Are you aware of the significance of entering a walled city on a colt/donkey?

What does this say about Jesus' mission?

Compare vs 7 - 8 with 2 Kings 9:13. What are the people saying about Jesus?
Hosanna means "rescue us" or "save us", what did they want saved from?
What do people today want saved/rescued from? But what do they NEED to be freed from?
Read Mark 11:12 - 14, 20 - 25
This is one of the most difficult passages in the whole of the Gospels! A miracle of destruction just doesn't seem to be 'right' What is happening?
If this is a "lived out parable" what does it say to the proclamation of our message to people of Grace?

Read Mark 14:3 - 9

What is new to you, or maybe something you don't understand?
This is obviously, at a human level, a complete and utter waste of money, so could Jesus praise her?
What are you willing to spend money on?
Read Matt 6:19 - 21. What are you willing to give?

Read Mark 14:10 - 11

In the context of what has just come before, what do you think of Judas?
Did Judas do it for the money?
Do you think Judas felt let down by Jesus?
We have been looking at sacrifice throughout this series of studies with the ultimate Sacrifice yet to come. Take time through this week to bring your difficulties, troubles and questions to Jesus. Don't let your confusion lead to betrayal.
Give thanks to Him, because He knows more than we do.
